Parental Rights Under Fire!

"Unpacking Illinois Policies Affecting Parental Rights and Child Safety"

Public Act 102-0522 (SB818): Passed

Comprehensive Sex Education, signed into law in August 2021, sexualizes, grooms, teaches masturbation, and promotes gender ideology.

HB346-LGBT History: Passed

The LGBT History law (signed into effect in August 2019) requires students to complete this history class in order to graduate from 8th grade.

HB370-Parental Notice of Abortion: Passed

Repeal of the Parental Notice of Abortion Act (signed in December 2021), where our daughters 17 and under can get an abortion without parental consent or notification.

HB29-Ford: Parental Bullying (Rules Committee)

The bill defines "parental bullying" as a parent intentionally sending verbal or visual messages to a minor that are believed to coerce, intimidate, harass, or cause emotional distress.

HB 5548-Canty: Access Gender Care (Rules Committee)

This bill mandates that the court limit parental control over a child's "gender change." It even interferes with parents' rights from other states.

HB 5473-Cassidy: Family Planning-Minors (Rules Committee)

Makes it legal for minors 12 years and over to make their own family planning decisions unilaterally without parental consent if the family is on Public Aid.

HB 4133-Croke: Bullying Prevention (Rules Committee)

Mandates that religious schools follow public schools' anti-bullying policies, covering LGBTQ content.

HB4876-Stava-Murray: Abortion/Gender Affirming Care (Rules Committee)

Criminalizes parents who deny their child access to certain medical care, such as primary care services, abortion services, or gender mutilation.

HB 1286-Stuart: All-gender restrooms (Passed the House)

Legalizes the conversion of "multiple-occupancy restrooms" into "all-gender restrooms," allowing both sexes to use the same facilities simultaneously.

HB 1596-Collins: Children Pronouns (Passed the House)

Gender-specific pronouns in various laws related to children have been replaced with gender-neutral terms like "the minor," "the child," "the applicant," or "the member."
